To ensure a safe and healthy environment for all the children, we ask that children exhibiting signs of illness remain at home. Please leave your child at home if you have seen any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours:

- Fever (100.2) or elevated temperature
- Discharge in or around the eyes
- Green or yellow runny nose
- Excessive coughing
- Head Lice
- Vomiting or Diarrhea
- Questionable rash

Any child who is being treated with an antibiotic should have received treatment for a minimum of 24 hours.

Check-in & Registration

TBC uses KidCheck to check in children on Sundays and during the week for childcare. Once your child is registered at kidcheck.com or by using the kidcheck app, you can use the touchscreen computers to check in your child. One label is for the child to wear, and the Guardian Receipt tag is for the parent to present to the nursery worker when you pick up your child. Your child will not be released without the Guardian Receipt tag.

Drop Off

- We request that only one parent check-in and pick-up the child to avoid congestion in the hall.
- For security reasons, only nursery volunteers are allowed to enter the classrooms. Every adult nursery volunteer or worker must have completed a background check.
- 20 Minute Rule – Children may not be dropped off later than 20 minutes after the service/class begins. This allows the class to settle and minimizes disruptions for the other children.
- Please do not “look in” on your child. This often upsets the child and many times the other children as well.
- Please pick up your child no later than 5 minutes after the service/class ends.

Should your child need you during the morning, you will be notified by text. Please make sure that your child's nametag correctly lists your cell phone number and keep your phone with you.

Class Assignment & Promotion

Nursery class assignments are based on physical and mental development in combination with your child's birthday. Please inform the Childcare Director when your child begins to crawl or walk and is ready to move to a different classroom.

TBC Promotion Sunday happens once a year in June. At that time, children who will be three years old by August 31 will promote to Preschool. All other (walking) children will promote to new classrooms in the nursery.

Nursing Mothers

A special room is provided in the main TBC foyer across from the Welcome Center, so that you may have a private, calm place to nurse your child. A changing table and supplies are also available for your use in the Nursing Mother's Room. For security reasons, please do not enter the Nursery classrooms to use the changing tables.
