PAUL'S 2ND LETTER TO THE CORINTHIANS

- Week **12** Questions -

Opening Question: Can you think of a fictional character or public figure you might describe as a “cheerful giver?”

Read **2 Corinthians 8:16-9:15** together.

Questions from the text

- Why was it important to Paul that others accompany Titus in delivering the gift?
- In what way does the ministry of giving lead to thanksgiving and glorifying God, according to vs. 12-13?

Cross Reference

- Read **Mark 10:21-22** together.
The rich man walked away sad where the Macedonians gave beyond their means with joy. What does our emotional response to giving reveal about what we treasure most?

Application Questions

- What role does prayer play in your acts of generosity? What would it look like for prayer to play a bigger role?
- What steps can you take to ensure that your generosity is done with integrity and transparency, like Paul describes?

Core Value: Community

- In what ways can cheerful and willing giving (financial, time, talents, etc.) strengthen the bonds of a church or small group community?
