PAUL'S 2ND LETTER TO THE CORINTHIANS

- Week **2** Questions -

Opening Question: How do you respond when things don't go according to your plans?

Read **2 Corinthians 1:12-2:11** together.

Questions from the text

- In verse 20 Paul states that “...all the promises of God find their “yes” in him.” How would you interpret this concept? What does it tell us about the role Jesus plays in fulfilling God’s promises?
- Chapter 2: 9-11 discusses forgiveness. What does this teach about how forgiveness impacts unity and spiritual health in Christian community?

Cross Reference

- Read **Colossians 1:21-22** together.

In thinking of forgiveness, this passage shows how God has forgiven those who were “...alienated and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds...” How does this inform our forgiveness of those outside Christian community?

Application Questions

- How can we practically extend grace in situations where we feel wronged or hurt?
- How do we balance showing mercy and grace while still standing firm in our faith and convictions?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- What practical steps can you take to cultivate trust in surrendering to God’s timing above your own during seasons of uncertainty?
