PAUL'S 2ND LETTER TO THE CORINTHIANS

- Week **7** Questions -

Opening Question: Have you ever acted as a representative or delegate for a group? Share your experience and how you approached the responsibility.

Read **2 Corinthians 5:11-21** together.

Questions from the text

- How does Paul's view of seeing no one "according to the flesh" inform the way we should relate to others?
- What are possible implications of God making His appeal "through us"? Why do we think this was His design?

Cross Reference

- Read **Ephesians 2:10** together.
How does being "God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works" relate to our calling to participate in the "ministry of reconciliation"?

Application Questions

- What are examples of how it looks to be "boasting in outward appearance" rather than the heart, even in Christian community?
- What are the responsibilities that come with being entrusted with "the ministry of reconciliation"? How do we share these with one another?

Core Value: Mission

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- What encouragement does it provide to us as believers to know that "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ"? Even in that, what weight do we feel knowing we carry the responsibility of being "ambassadors for Christ" in His "Ministry of Reconciliation"?
