PAUL'S 2ND LETTER TO THE CORINTHIANS

- Week 8 Questions -

Opening Question: Share a time when you felt unfairly treated or misunderstood. How did you respond in the moment?

Read **2 Corinthians 6:1-13** together.

Questions from the text

- Paul warns against receiving “the grace of God in vain” in v. 1. What are other biblical examples of someone/some group receiving “the grace of God in vain.”
- How do Paul’s experiences teach us about resiliency and integrity in the face of suffering or misunderstanding? Why is this important?

Cross Reference

- Read **Isaiah 49:8** together.

Paul cites a prophecy from Isaiah’s when he claims that “...now is the favorable time...” How might it have felt for the Church at Corinth to read that God’s promise of salvation is not just prophetic anymore, but present and urgent?

Application Questions

- How can we find ourselves restricted by our own affections outside of Christ? How does this impact our effectiveness as we aim to “...proclaim the gospel to the whole creation (Mark 15:16).”
- What is one practical step you can take this week to widen your heart toward someone? What might hold you back?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- How can we surrender “obstacles” in your life that might hinder others from seeing the truth of the gospel through you?
