



Part 1 Questions

Opening Question: What is something so different about you that sets you apart from the rest of your group?

Read **Exodus 19:1-6** together.

Questions from the text

- What were the three things God told Moses that Israel will be if they obey him and keep his covenant? What sticks out to you about these three characteristics?

Cross Reference

- Read **1 Peter 2:9-10** together.
Peter used direct wording from God's words to Moses to show Gentile believers that they too receive these traits. How have you seen the Church exhibit these characteristics?

Application Questions

- God said we are his treasured possession. What proof do you find in Scripture or your own life that speaks to God treasuring you?
- Priests are not priests for themselves, but stand before God on behalf of others. Israel was called to be priests for the world and so are we, the Church. We are to bring others to the Lord. How have you seen the Church excel and fail at this?
- What does it mean to be holy? What is the purpose of holiness?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- God did the work first by rescuing Israel and bringing them to himself. Our surrender is not the start of salvation but the response to God's work of salvation. Before coming to Christ, how did the Lord bring you to himself?
