Opening Question: What is something people associate with you?

Read **Exodus 34:10-35**

Questions from the text

- What was the purpose of all the feasts the Lord commanded Israel to keep?
- What does God's jealous nature tell us about him?

Cross Reference

- Read **Proverbs 13:20** together.

God told Moses they are to not be in such close relationships with the inhabitants of the land for they will drag down Israel. How do you balance your relationship with those who do not walk with Christ so they do not pull you away from him?

Application Questions

- God told Israel that he would clear the way for them to take the land he promised them. He would drive out the people, but Israel was to break their wicked traditions. What parts of our culture should we break and not be allowed inside the body of Christ?
- As Moses continued to spend time in the presence of God, he began to change in a way he did not see but others could. As you walk with Christ, what have others pointed out about your changed character that you did not realize?

Core Value: Mission

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- God is going to do incredible things and all the other nations will see God's hand at work for Israel. But he wants the nations to also observe Israel's devotion to him. When God is at work, the nations will be looking at his followers. How have you seen God's power and the church's devotion to him work together on display for nonbelievers to see?
