Opening Question: Have you ever followed something but ended up getting lost?

Read **Exodus 40**

Questions from the text

- How does the meticulous attention to detail in setting up the tabernacle reflect the importance of obedience and order in worship?
- The cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. What is the significance of God's glory filling the tabernacle in this way, and what does it signify about God's relationship with his people?

Cross Reference

- Read **1 Corinthians 3:16-17** together.
Considering that the tabernacle was the place where God's presence dwelled, how does Paul's teaching of believers as temples of the Holy Spirit deepen our understanding of God's presence in our lives?

Application Questions

- The cloud guided Israel throughout their journey. What does this imagery of God's presence as a guiding force teach us about relying on God for direction in our lives?
- How can we apply the principles of God's glory and holiness from this passage to enhance our worship and relationship with God?
