



## Week 2 Questions

*Opening Question: What was a promise you committed to without knowing the stakes?*

Read **Exodus 19:7-25** together.

### *Questions from the text*

- Why do the people of Israel need to be consecrated? What does consecrated mean?
- Why could the people not even touch the mountain?

### *Cross Reference*

- Read **John 5:45-47** together.

Jesus lists Moses as one of his witnesses to testify he is who he says he is. In Exodus 19, the people of Israel were given a spectacular reason to trust that Moses bore messages from the Lord. Yet the Jews trust Moses and not Jesus. Why do you think people nowadays can accept that God is real, but not accept Jesus?

### *Application Questions*

- “They are closing their religious tinder profile, and deleting the app.” In other words, they are shutting off the ways of the world and walking in the ways of God. What are some things you had to walk away from when you decided to dedicate your life to Christ?
- Describe your purpose as a Christian? How did you come to understand your purpose?

### *Core Value: Surrender*

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.
