Opening Question: What is something you are very, very particular about?

Read **Exodus 11:1-13:17** together.

Questions from the text

- Why is God being so particular in this passage?
- What things do you see about this passage that foreshadow Jesus?

Cross reference

- Read **John 1:29** together.

John the Baptist proclaims one of the many names of Jesus: The Lamb of God. When meditating on Jesus as the Lamb of God, what comes to mind?

Application Questions

- The Lord is showing that it is important to stop and observe a time to remember him and what he has done. What are ways throughout the year you or our culture stop and observe a time to remember what the Lord has done? How serious do you take these moments? What does it look like to not just go through the motions on these days?
- How would you describe your freedom from sin in Christ to someone in bondage?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- God is the one with power and authority to keep Israel from the judgment of the tenth plague, but he requires obedience from them in order to partake in salvation from the plague. What is required of us to receive freedom from death?
