Opening Question: When was the last time you grumbled?

Read **Exodus 17-18** together.

Questions from the text

- How was Moses feeling at the beginning of Exodus 17? How would you feel?
- What was Jethro's response to Moses's story? Why did he respond this way?

Cross Reference

- Read **Lamentations 3:22-23** together.

The Lord showed mercy to Israel that in their grumbling he brought them water. How would you describe the mercy of the Lord to someone who does not know the Lord?

Application Questions

- When was a time you may have asked "Is the Lord here with me?" How does someone move away from that feeling?
- Jethro rejoiced for what the Lord did for Moses and Israel. What is something in someone else's life you have rejoiced for?

Core Value: Community

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- Moses was losing strength to hold up his own hands, so Aaron and Hur held them up for him. Even as God's chosen leader of the Israelite, Moses relied on others for victories. How have others come alongside you as you surrender to the Lord?
