Opening Question: Recount a time you really stumbled on your words.

Read Exodus 6:14-7:13 together.

Questions from the text

- The short genealogy outlines that "these are the Moses and Aaron to whom the Lord" spoke. Why is it significant to remember just exactly who these men were?
- Since Pharaoh's heart was hardened, why do you think Moses and Aaron even needed to try and convince him to let the Israelites leave?

Cross reference

• Read 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 together.

Paul recounts his weakness in speech, a similar issue that Moses faces. What happens when one's faith rests in the "wisdom of men" and not "the power of God"? When have you experienced this or seen others experience this?

Application Questions

- God repeats his promises to Moses after he again questions how this is going to happen. What has been a promise of God you have had to hear over and over again until it stuck?
- Pharaoh is unconvinced after seeing the staff turn into a serpent. When have you told someone about the Lord and they were still unconvinced? How did you respond to that?

Core Value: Mission

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

• God continued to show Moses that he will take care of what needs to be done, but Moses seemed to continue to think God's plans were dependent on his own strength. As we strive to join God and be on mission for him, what does it look like to be obedient in our actions but dependent for the outcomes?
