Opening Question: What names of God have resonated with you the most?

Read **Exodus 3** together.

Questions from the text

- This is the first use of the word “Holy” in scripture. What does it mean that the ground was made holy?
- How does Moses respond to God’s plan? Why do you think he responded this way? How would you respond?
- Why do you think God would have Moses approach Pharaoh first even though he knows Pharaoh will not release the Israelites?

Cross reference

- Read **John 8:52-59** together.
What are the implications of Jesus’ declaration in verse 58? Why did the Jews respond to him in the way that they did? Why is it hard for people to understand who Jesus truly is?

Application Questions

- God commands Moses to tell the elders that his name is to be remembered throughout all generations. How are you or how do you plan to help the next generation remember?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- The Lord is asking Moses to do his will in a dangerous place in a dangerous way. Moses does what we all might naturally do—he questions his own ability to do the Lord’s will. But God responds that he himself is the orchestrator of the events to come, not Moses. What does it look like to set aside your own shortcomings in order to serve the Lord where and how he asks you to serve?
