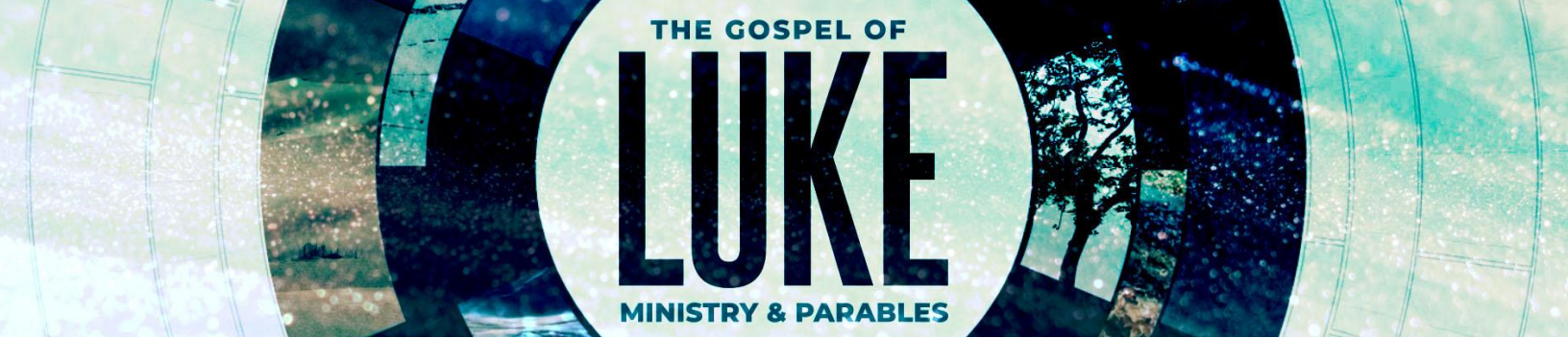




- Week **11** Questions -

Opening Question: What's something you've been excited to tell other people recently?

Read **Luke 10:1-24** together.

Questions from the text

- In vv. 1-2, Jesus says, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." Unpack this quote and relate it to our contemporary context? Why is it relevant for believers to consider today?
- Jesus pronounces woes on Chorazin, Bethsaida, and Capernaum. Why does greater exposure to God's revelation bring greater accountability?

Cross Reference

- Read **2 Timothy 3:12-16** together.
- What do these passages teach about what it means to be a fully surrendered disciple of Jesus? Identify the difficulties, but also the reward of faithful obedience.

Application Questions

- Jesus sent the disciples out despite the risks. What fears or obstacles most often keep you from sharing your faith or serving others in Jesus' name?
- Looking at the whole passage, which parts of Jesus' instructions or teaching do we find most challenging to obey and why?

Core Value: Surrender

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- Discuss the difference between surrendering your life to Christ's purposes and simply trying to achieve spiritual success?
