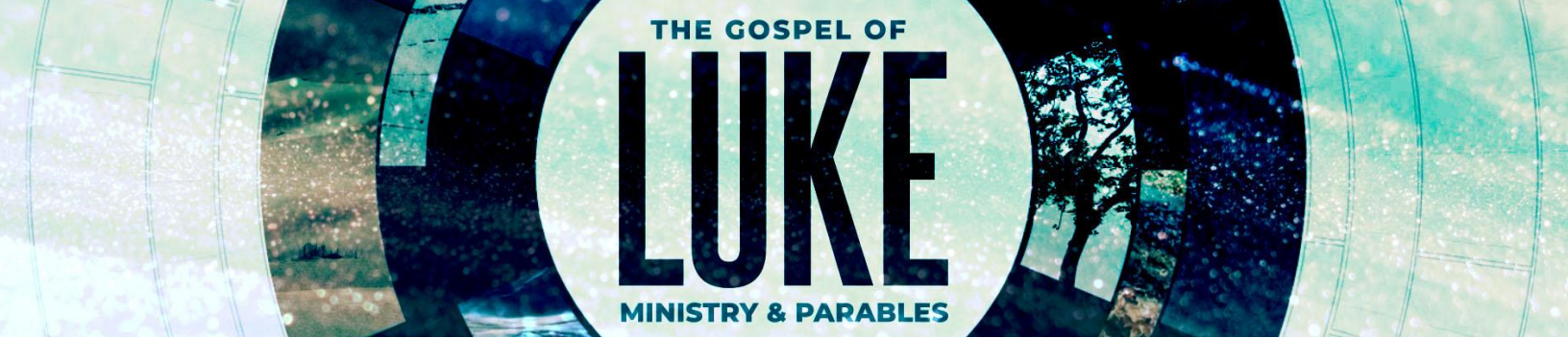




- Week **12** Questions -

Opening Question: If you had one completely free day to serve your community, how would you spend that time?

Read **Luke 10:25-37** together.

Questions from the text

- Compare the responses of the priest, the Levite, and the Samaritan. Compare similarities and differences then discuss why they are significant in Jesus' parable?
- How does Jesus change the lawyer's question? What is the significance of that shift?

Cross Reference

- Read **1 John 3:16-18** together.
- If our small group and others were to consistently obey both Luke 10:37 and 1 John 3:18, what could be the result?

Application Questions

- Like the lawyer, in what subtle ways do we try to justify ourselves before God or others instead of honestly examining our hearts?
- Compassion cost the Samaritan time, comfort, money, and convenience. Which of those can be hardest to bear when serving others? Why?
