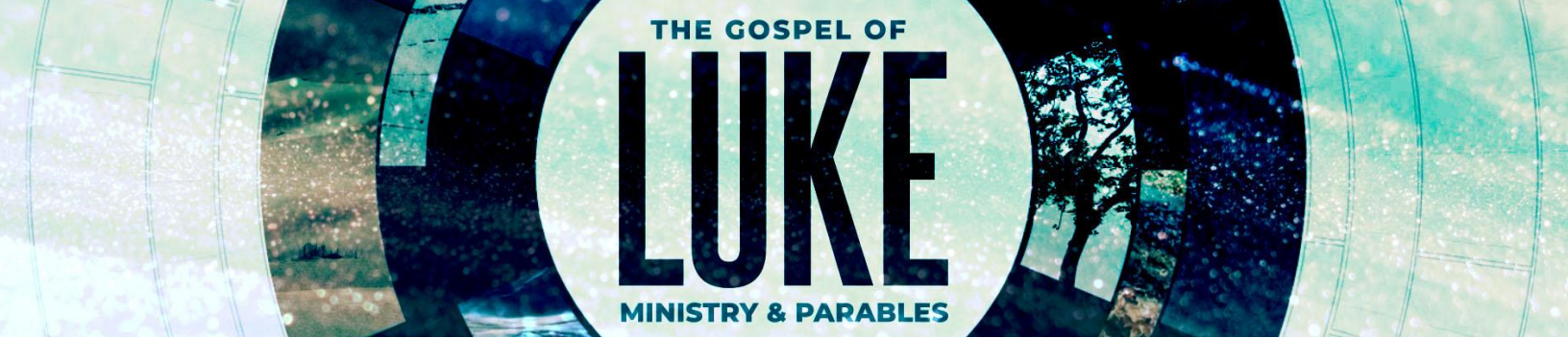




- Week **13** Questions -

Opening Question: What's one task you can get completely absorbed in without realizing how much time has passed?

Read **Luke 10:38-42** together.

Questions from the text

- According to v. 39, what is Mary doing? What is significant about the phrase "sat at the Lord's feet and listened to his teaching"?
- Jesus says Mary "has chosen the good portion." What contrast is Luke drawing between Martha's and Mary's choices throughout this account?

Cross Reference

- Read **Colossians 3:1-4** together.
- In Luke 10, Mary chooses the "good portion." How does Colossians 3:1-4 help us understand what that "good portion" ultimately is?

Application Questions

- How can we distinguish between faithful service to Christ and allowing ministry, work, or responsibilities to replace intimacy with Christ?
- Jesus didn't rebuke Martha for serving, but for being anxious and distracted. What does this teach us about God's concern for our hearts, not just our actions?

Core Value: Community

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- How can our small group, family, or church encourage one another to prioritize communion with Christ over simply staying busy?
