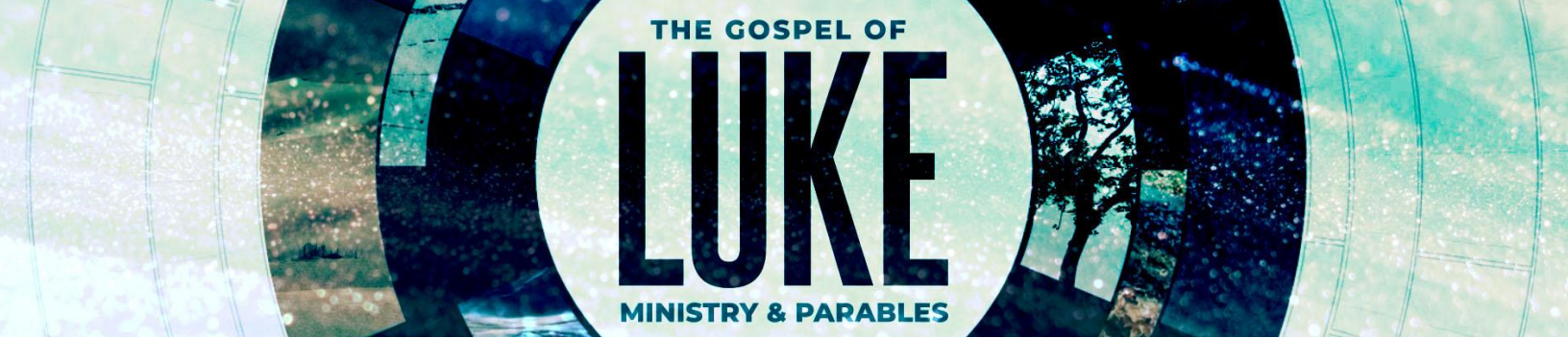




- Week **3** Questions -

Opening Question: What's a time you thought something was a disaster in the moment but turned out completely fine afterward?

Read **Luke 8:16-25** together.

Questions from the text

- In verse 17, what two parallel statements are made about hidden and secret things, and how do they reinforce each other?
- After Jesus calms the storm in vv. 24-25, what responses are attributed to the disciples? How do their responses lead to questioning about Jesus' identity?

Cross Reference

- Read **Colossians 1:5-16** together.
- In Luke 8:25, the disciples ask, "Who then is this?" How does Colossians 1:15 help answer their question?

Application Questions

- Jesus says to "take care how you hear." What are some practical steps we take to become more attentive and obedient listeners of God's Word?
- How should Jesus' redefinition of family in v. 21 shape our priorities and relationships with other believers?

Core Value: Surrender

- Jesus' own disciples marvel and question who He is after witnessing his authority over the storm. How does our personal recognition of Jesus' authority over all things affect the way we trust Him in our lives?
