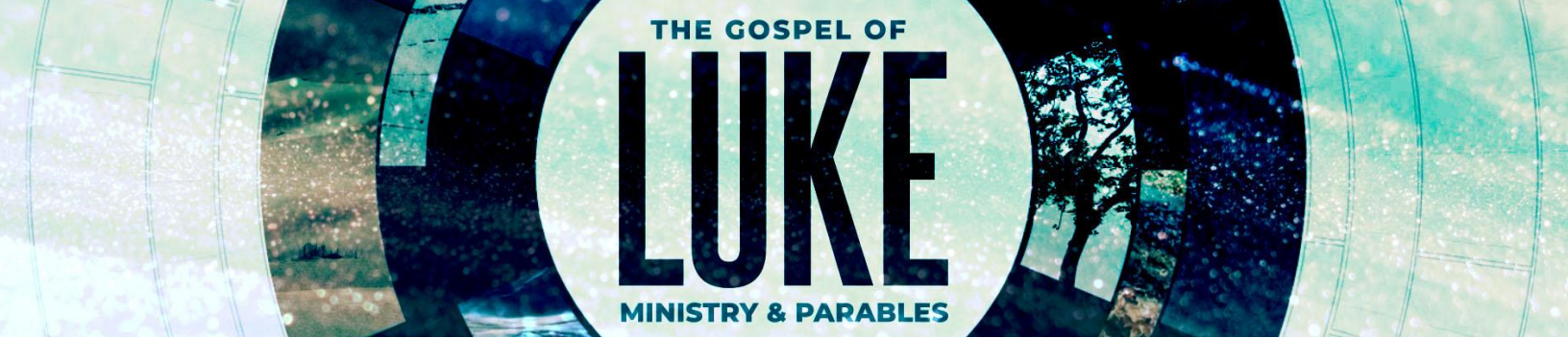




- Week 6 Questions -

Opening Question: What's a time when something small ended up being more than enough?

Read **Luke 9:1-17** together.

Questions from the text

- Why do you think Jesus instructed the disciples to “take nothing for your journey” in verse 3? What might that have taught them?
- In verses 14–16, what details in the feeding of the five thousand highlight Jesus’ authority, compassion, and provision?

Cross Reference

- Read **Romans 10:11-15** together.
- How does Romans 10:11–15 reinforce the importance of the mission Jesus gives His disciples in Luke 9:1–6?

Application Questions

- What are some areas in our lives where it can be difficult to trust God rather than our own preparation or security? How can we increase our trust in Him?
- Everyone in the crowd “ate and was satisfied.” In what ways are people tempted to look for satisfaction apart from Christ?

Core Value: Mission

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- The disciples experienced both ministry success and rejection. How can believers remain faithful to mission even when results are unclear or discouraging?
