Opening Question: *Who is someone who really impacted your faith?*

Read **Philippians 2:19-30** together.

Questions from the text

- What characteristics of Paul's explanation of Timothy stand out to you the most?
- What does it mean to be a "brother, worker, and soldier"?

Cross Reference

- Read **Ephesians 6:21-22** together.
Paul sends messengers to encourage the recipients about his wellbeing and his ministry. What has been your experience of being encouraged by what believers are doing elsewhere for the ministry of the gospel?

Application Questions

- In what ways can we cultivate a genuine care for others, as Timothy did, in our community or church?
- Paul calls Timothy a "true son" in the faith. What does this teach us about the importance of mentorship and discipleship in the Christian life?

Core Value: Community

As we look in Scripture, we see ways we are directed to surrender to Christ, be a part of his biblical community, and participate in his mission.

- Paul emphasizes honoring those who serve sacrificially in ministry. How can we practically honor and recognize those who give so much for the gospel?
