# **QUICK REVIEW:**

This week we continue with our series Learning From Jesus, a look at the Sermon on the Mount. This is probably the most famous teaching section by Jesus found in Scripture, providing his disciples a contrasting framework for viewing their lives with each other and God than was popularly held. Was there anything from this week's sermon that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? How would you summarize the main ideas of this week's message?

# **DIGGING DEEPER:**

Read Matthew 5:27-28.

- 1) Jesus had already told them he was here to "fulfill the law" and that their "righteousness must exceed that" of the Pharisees (Matt. 5:17-20). How does what he says here fit with that?
- 2) What does actual adultery and lusting after someone have in common? Why is that a problem?
- 3) How does our culture view lust? Does the culture ever seem to be double minded? Are Jesus's words here applicable to women also? Why or why not?
- 4) How would Jesus respond to the idea, "You can look but don't touch"?

- 8) Does the existence of biblical grounds for divorce mean it is necessary or required in those situations? How should the Church counsel those considering divorce?

- 2) What is one thing you can do this week to help strengthen your marriage or bless your spouse?
